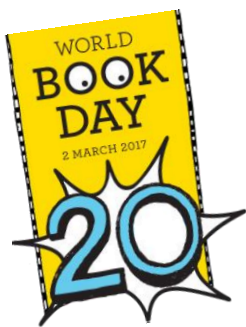

## Parent Consultations

## School Meals – Price Increase

The price of school meals is increasing from £2.05 to £2.15 per day with effect from 24<sup>th</sup> April 2016. The increase

is required to enable Edwards and Ward to adjust some of their pay rates to meet the new Living Wage commitment.

**The cost of a week will therefore be £10.75 in terms 5 and 6.** All Infant school meals will continue to be free.

## Reporting Near Misses on route to school
