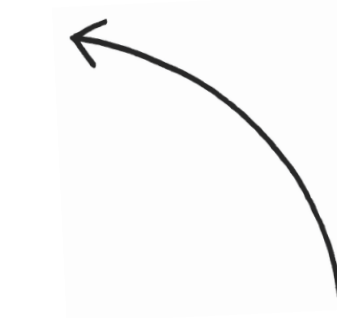


We will celebrate the end of the topic by having a class celebration. Children will also be encouraged to look back over their work and discuss what they have learnt.

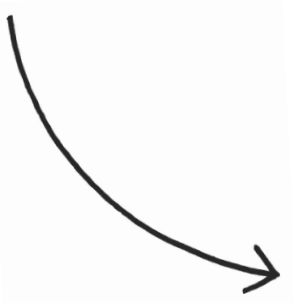


Weeks 1 & 2

Baseline (weeks 1-3)

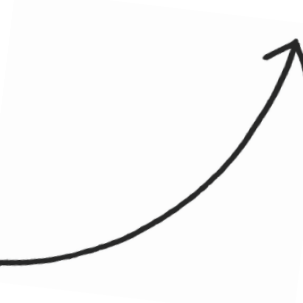
Counting and number recognition (weeks 4-6)

Main Learning Focus: Listening and behaviour

Children will:

- Agree upon core classroom rules and expectations.
- Use the children's story Elmer as a starting point to discuss and celebrate individuality and diversity.
- Learn about 2D Shapes/Colours
- Be introduced to numbers through the Number Puppy stories.
- Learn about different rhyming stories and alliteration (Room on the Broom, The Gruffalo etc).
