Weekly Overview: To use mathematical names for 'solid' 3D shapes, and mathematical terms to describe them. To revise phase 3 sounds and to learn the Sight Word 'all'.

<p>Phonics <u>We are learning to spell two syllable words.</u> Play <i>Flashcards and Tricky Word Trucks</i> on https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/ (phase 2/3 sounds).</p> <p>Ask children to spell a two syllable word (tonight, rooftop, farmyard, bedroom, lightning). Hold up a card with the word on. Ask chn to correct mistakes.</p>	<p>Phonics <u>We are learning to read captions.</u> Play 'Quickwrite' - You say a sound and your child writes it down. Correct your child's letter formation, if needed (c, a, o, d, g, q, e, s, f, sh, th, ai, igh, oo, or, ow, ear, ure).</p> <p>Children to read sentences about a farm and to draw pictures to go with them. (Pdf attached).</p>	<p>Phonics <u>We are learning to read the sight word 'all'.</u> Play <i>Flashcards and Tricky Word Trucks</i> on https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/ (phase 2/3 sounds).</p> <p>Show your child the sight word 'all' and ask them to write it down as many times as they can in a minute. Can your child say a sentence which contains the sight word 'all'? Challenge - Write the sentence.</p>	<p>Phonics <u>We are practising blending to read words.</u> Play 'Quickwrite' - You say a sound and your child writes it down. Correct your child's letter formation, if needed (r, b, n, h, m, k, p, ch, ng, ee, oa, ar, ur, oi, air).</p> <p>Recap a couple of sounds your child is finding tricky.</p> <p>Play <i>Buried Treasure</i> on https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/. Enter the following words; thing, short, arch, longer, chort, arth, zicker.</p>	<p>Phonics <u>We are practising writing words in sentences.</u> Play <i>Flashcards and Tricky Word Trucks</i> on https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/ (phase 2/3 sounds).</p> <p>Ask your child to make a zigzag book about a farm. They will need to draw pictures and write captions. (Pdf attached).</p>
<p>Maths Go on a 3D shape hunt around your house. Can you find a cube, a pyramid, a sphere, a cylinder or a cuboid? Talk to your child about the 'faces' and 'edges' on each of the shapes.</p>	<p>Maths Create a collection of small objects that are 3D shapes, such as a small ball, a toy brick, a dice and a glue stick. Hide the objects in a bag and then put your hand in the bag to choose one of the objects.</p>	<p>Maths Make a ramp on the carpet. Predict which 3D shape will travel down the ramp fastest/slowest. Are your predictions correct?</p>	<p>Maths Make a 3D shape museum in your bedroom. Collect 3D shapes from around the house. Can your child find a cube, a cylinder, a pyramid, a sphere or a cuboid?</p>	<p>Maths Make a 3D shape box monster!</p> 

	Take turns to describe and guess the shape.
