Phonics

This week we are learning to read and write CCVC words such as spot, step, stop, skip, trip, plan, from, frog, twin, swim.

Watch the teachers' phonics videos on Tapestry, including Monday's 'How to read and write CCVC words'.

Challenge 1: Play 'hide n seek' words. Ask a grown up to hide paper words around the house. Can you find them and read them all? How might you use each word in a sentence? (PDF attached)

Challenge 2: Write some CVCC words (see above). Can you challenge yourself to write a sentence with one or more words in?

Activity 3: Can you bang/strum/tap a musical instrument 20 times? Can you count the sounds accurately and aloud?
