Phonics

Watch the teachers' phonics videos on Tapestry on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. This week they will be teaching your children to read some high frequency words (words we use a lot), such as; said, so, do, have, like, some, come and were. We will be learning to write words with adjacent consonants such as; street, spring, scrunch and blink.

We will also be learning to read sight words do, when, out and what as well as writing sight words my, all and her.
