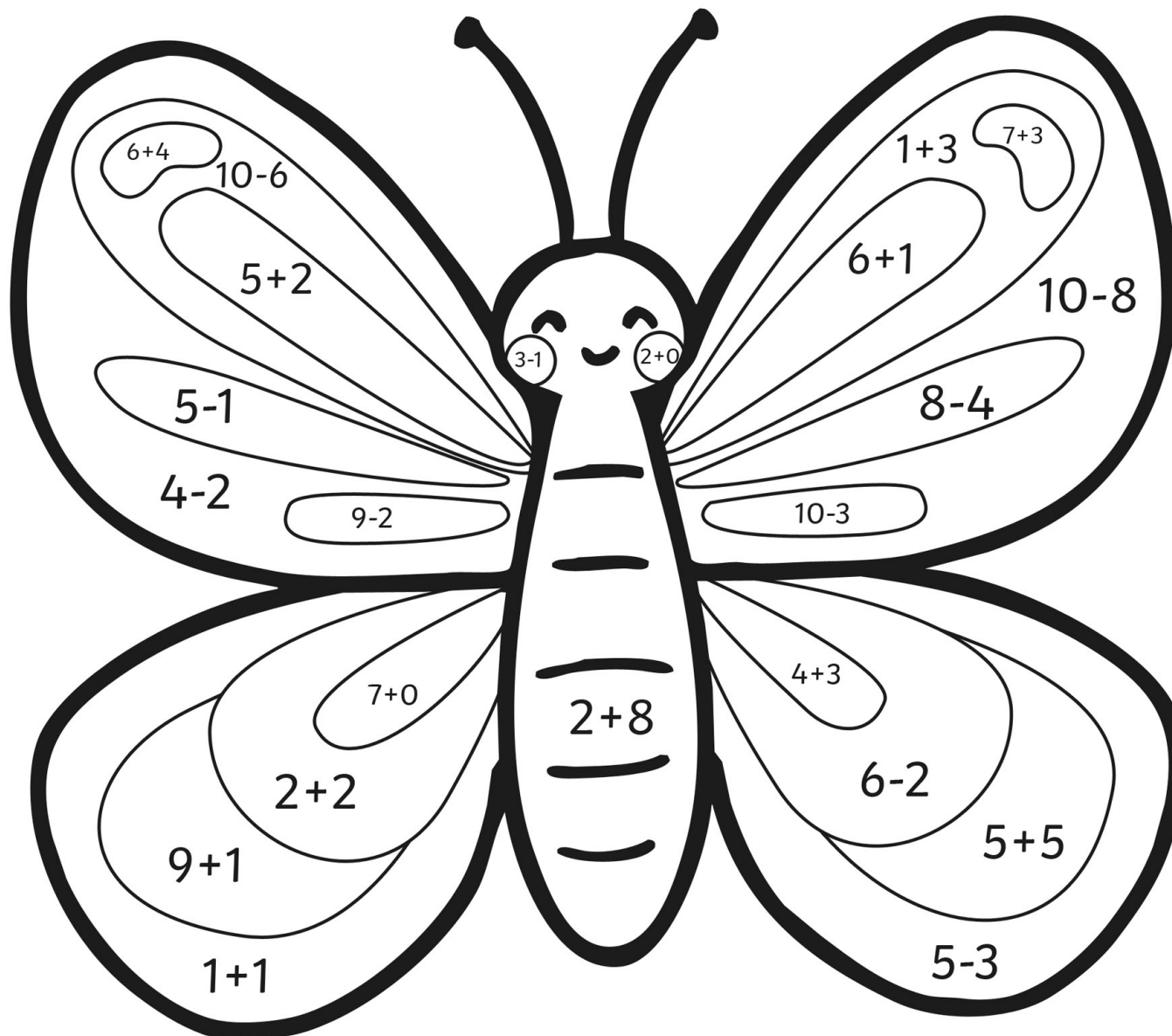


# Minibeast Colour by Number Addition and Subtraction Up to 10

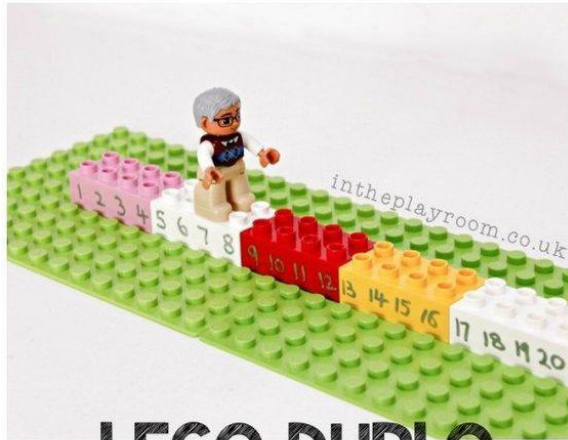
Solve the calculations in the picture to work out what colours they should be!

### Maths Game #2: Subtraction Skittles



Play a game of skittles. If you don't have skittles you can use empty bottles or toilets roll tubes. Number each 'skittle' before you play.

Ask your child;

- How many skittles are there altogether?
- Which number did you knock down?
- How many skittles did you knock over?
- How many are left?
- **Challenge:** Can you write this as a subtraction number sentence?

### Maths Game #3: Subtraction Squish

Use a piece of masking tape to create a number line on the kitchen floor. (0-10 or 0-20 depending on your child).

Before you play, your child will need to roll quite a few playdough balls - this is great for improving fine motor skills. Then it is time to play!

Ask your child a subtraction problem. For example "What is 6 take away 4?" Ask your child to line up the correct number of balls, in this case 6, and then to squish 4 in order to find out the answer.
