## Phonics

Watch the teachers' phonics videos on Tapestry on Monday, Wednesday and Friday. This week they will be teaching your children to read polysyllabic words with adjacent consonants, such as, *lunchbox*, *helpdesk*, *windmill*, *treetop*, *starlight*, *desktop*, *sandwich* and *sandpit*. We will also be learning to read the words 'were', 'there', 'little' and 'one' and to spell the words 'was' and 'you'.

**Phonics Challenge:** Cut out the pictures and stick them up around your house. Ask your child to put a tick next to the corresponding word on the spotting sheet. To make the challenge harder, you could ask your child to write the word, or to write a sentence containing the word.

**Activity 1:** Building brick addition and subtraction board game (PDF attached)

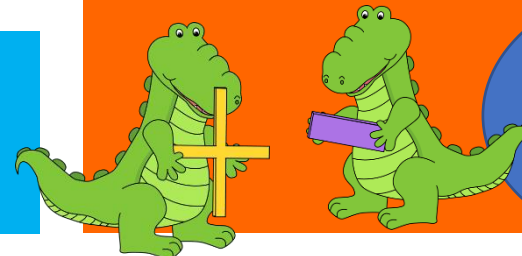
**Activity 2:** Make a Duplo/Lego number line to help with addition/subtraction problems. (See PDF for instructions)
